This program, set in Nepal, uses experiential activities designed to develop an understanding of key social and community development issues impacting the country. In Nepal, you will co-learn with local students from by visiting local historical, environmental and cultural sites, community development agencies, markets, and schools. By engaging with the local people with local environments, you will be introduced to the history, knowledge and geo and socio-political contexts of Nepal. These experiences will help you to understand social issues and policies and the links between the micro, mezzo and macro factors that impact social work and community development in Nepal. This learning can be applied to your community practice in Canada.
