- Program for Undergraduate Research Experience
 - 8, 12, or 16-week full-time research projects
 - May August 2021
 - **Value:** \$3,000 \$6,000
- Eligibility
 - Full-time UCalgary BSW student, not graduating in June
 - Good academic standing (usually GPA of 3.2 or higher)
 - UCalgary Faculty Supervisor
- Application deadline: early February 2021 (TBA)
- Applications open early December 2020

Alberta Innovates – Health Solutions Summer Studentship

- Program for undergraduate students to conduct medical or healthoriented research
 - 8, 12, or 16-week research projects
 - May August 2021
 - **Value:** \$1,500 per month

Eligibility

- Full-time student
- Good academic standing (GPA of 3.2 or higher)
- Proposed projects must be in an area of health-related research
- UCalgary Faculty Supervisor actively engaged in health-oriented research
- Application deadline: early February 2021 (TBA)
- Applications open early December 2020

Mitacs Globalink Research Awards

- Senior undergraduate and graduate students to participate in a research project with a foreign university in one of the Mitacs' partner countries (e.g. Brazil, China, India, Mexico, France, Israel)
 - 12 24-week research projects
 - Value: up to \$6,000

Eligibility

- Full-time students
- Good academic standing (a B average or higher)
- UCalgary Faculty Supervisor eligible to hold Tri-Council funding
- Faculty Supervisor in one of the Mitacs' partner countries
- Application deadline: ongoing/check webpage below (limited to 200 applications per fiscal year)

Canadian Institute for Health Research (CIHR) Summer Studentship Award

- CIHR Summer Studentship Award Institute
 Community Support
 - not offered every year
- Undergraduate student to undertake health research projects with established investigators in an environment that provides strong mentorship
- Value: \$5,000 for four months (may vary)
- Application deadline: January 2021 (if applicable)

Presenting Your Research

Undergraduate Research Symposium

- Provides UCalgary undergraduate students with an opportunity to showcase their research
- Annual event (end of November), main campus (Calgary)
 - This year online (apply to present by October 5, 2020)
- Offers cash awards (\$500 to \$1,000) and poster grants
- You can apply for Students' Union Travel and Conference Funding (in future years when it is back to face-to-face)

 UCalgary undergraduate students who have been awarded a PURE award in the same year;
- Covers travel expenses related to presenting student's research at a conference within 6 months of the application deadline;
- Due Sept. 30, 2020;
- Value: \$1,350;

- Journal of Undergraduate Research in Alberta (JURA)
 - Specifically targeted at publishing research performed by undergraduates and written up by undergraduates;

- Faculty of Social Work Publication Fund
 - Fosters FSW students' excellence in research through supporting peer-reviewed publications;
 - Student must be first author, mentored by a Faculty member (\$300 five awards per year);
 - Deadlines: April 15 & November 15;
