RESEARCH STUDY LOOKING FOR **PEER FACILITATORS** for the project Digital storytelling: An intervention model for inclusion and capacity building among youth with developmental disabilities

We are looking for youth who:

- self-identify as a person with a developmental disability
- are between 18-30 years of age
- are enrolled in a full or part time post-secondary program

to take part in a facilitator training workshop where they will complete a digital story about their experiences transitioning into post-secondary, work, and/or community living.

Digital stories are short films. People use images, words, and music to create a 2-5 minute video about a life event. No previous technical skills are needed.

The facilitator training workshop includes six online sessions over a two week period. Workshops will take place between July 2021- September 2021, depending on enrollment.

After completing the workshop, facilitators receive a certificate of completion. Facilitators have the opportunity to co-facilitate future 2021 workshops. Timing for workshops depends on enrollment. Facilitators receive \$250 honorarium for every workshop facilitated.
