- Program for Undergraduate Research Experience
 - 8, 12, or 16-week full-time research projects
 - May – August 2021
 - **Value:** up to \$7,500 (\$1,875/month)
- **Eligibility**
 - Full-time UCalgary BSW student, not graduating in June
 - Good academic standing (cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher)
 - UCalgary Faculty Supervisor
- **Application deadline:** February 4, 2022

- Program for undergraduate students to conduct medical or health-oriented research
 - 8, 12, or 16-week research projects
 - May – August 2021
 - **Value:** \$1,500 per month (may be subject to change)
- **Eligibility**
 - Full-time student
 - Good academic standing (GPA of 3.2 or higher)
 - Proposed projects must be in an area of health-related research
 - UCalgary Faculty Supervisor actively engaged in health-oriented research
- **Application deadline:** February 4, 2022 (Same as PURE)

- Senior undergraduate and graduate students to participate in a research project with a foreign university in one of the Mitacs' partner countries (e.g. Brazil, China, India, Mexico, France, Israel)
 - 12 – 24-week research projects
 - **Value:** up to \$6,000
- **Eligibility**
 - Full-time students
 - Good academic standing (a B average or higher)
 - UCalgary Faculty Supervisor eligible to hold Tri-Council funding
 - Faculty Supervisor in one of the Mitacs' partner countries
- **Application deadline:** ongoing/check webpage below (limited to 200 applications per fiscal year)

- **CIHR Summer Studentship Award – Institute Community Support**
 - not offered every year
- Undergraduate student to undertake health research projects with established investigators in an environment that provides strong mentorship
- **Value:** \$5,000 for four months (may vary)
- **Application deadline:** January 2022 (if applicable)
