ESSENTIAL FUNCTION:

- Identify, document and respond to physical, emotional and behavioral indicators of abuse, neglect and emotional injury
- Perform Structured Decision Making Risk assessments (SDM) at all required points in the life of a case file
- Assess strengths and needs of children and families in consultation with the family
- Engage children and families in the ongoing assessment and case planning process
- Conduct face to face interviews with children and families to gather information
- Ensure goals and tasks are specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, time limited and clearly understood by everyone involved in the case planning process
- Ensure the development of a safety plan and required supports are identified within the plan
- Ensure all legal and procedural requirements are completed for court purposes in a timely manner
- Attend court to give testimony to case facts
- Participate in the on call schedule for after hour services on a rotational basis
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements:

- B.S.W or B.I.S.W, required to register with Saskatchewan Association of Social Workers
- Two years Child Welfare experience is preferred, but not required
