## **Abstract:**

We welcome student-led proposals for virtual or in-person poster presentations focusing on *Global to Local: Collaborating with Communities to Create Change* and tackling social justice issues through research engaging a variety of perspectives/disciplines

- Type of research to be presented: original research (completed or in progress)
- Format: title (centered at top of page & bold), research question/purpose, methodology/intervention strategies, findings/practice outcomes, discussion, and references
- Anonymous: do not include the authors in the abstract body
- Word limit: 200 (not including the title, references, figures and tables, if applicable), word count visible
- Single-spaced
- Filename (based on the first author's name): lastname\_firstname.pdf

## **Guidelines:**

- Students (all levels), faculty members and community partners from all Faculty of Social Work regions are welcome to submit their proposals for poster presentations; we encourage posters to be presented by a student co-author

- Indicate in the body of your email: all authors; title; and preferred presentation location (virtual, Calgary or Edmonton)
