




Embarking on your Graduate Certificate Journey



- The Advanced Social Work Practice certificate consists of 4 courses, SOWK 600, 602, 604, and 606, that will explore core elements of social work knowledge and practice.
- This curriculum will examine social justice, research strategies, social work practice models, and public policy with the intent of further developing student's unique social work perspective and strengthening their social work identity and personal practice framework.









- 4 courses over 8 months
 - 2 courses in Fall term
 - 2 courses in Winter term
 - Courses run sequentially
 - Must pass each course to move to the next course
- Blended learning
 - Synchronous and asynchronous learning
 - Scheduled class times: Tuesdays & Thursdays,5:30PM 8:30PM



Graduate Level Expectations

- More than professional development
- Time commitment (weekly readings/prep, asynchronous learning activities & Zoom sessions plus assignments)
- Fixed deadlines for course completion
- Academic writing (Student Success Centre)
- Referencing (APA 7th edition)
- Academic misconduct



Graduate Level Expectations

- B- (75-79%) is a minimum pass for students in graduate studies
- Students who accumulate two grades of B- or lower can be required by the Faculty to withdraw from the program
