- The Practical & Transformational Leader certificate consists of 4 courses, SOWK 649, 647, 648, and 643, that will explore core elements of social work knowledge and practice.
- This certificate provides practical skills that will help you become a transformational leader. The program provides knowledge and skills such as strategic planning, budgeting and human resources, to transforming an organization to achieve its mandate. You'll learn current theories and practices in leadership within a variety of organizational contexts. A wide array of topics include program planning, implementation and evaluation; policy analysis and development; organizational dynamics and change; supervision; community capacity building, social action and advocacy.

Transformational Leadership & Supervision in Human Services



- 4 courses over 8 months
 - 2 courses in Fall term
 - 2 courses in Winter term
 - Courses run sequentially
 - Must pass each course to move to the next course
- Blended learning


